DESCRIPTION

The TS3DDR3642 is 1:2 or 2:1 high speed DDR2/DDR3 switch that offers 12-bit wide bus switching. The A port can be switched to the B or C port for all bits simultaneously. Designed for operation in DDR2 and DDR3 memory bus systems, the TS3DDR3642 uses a proprietary architecture that delivers high bandwidth (-3dB bandwidth at 4.5GHz), low insertion loss at low frequency, and very low propagation delay. The TS3DDR3642 is 1.8V logic compatible, and all switches are bi-directional for added design flexibility. The TS3DDR3642 also offers a power-down mode, in which all channels become high-Z and the device operates with minimal power.

TYPICAL APPLICATION DIAGRAM




Figure 1. Typical Application Diagram showing Memory Bus Switching


Pb-Free (RoHS): TI's terms "Lead-Free" or "Pb-Free" mean semiconductor products that are compatible with the current RoHS requirements for all 6 substances, including the requirement that lead not exceed 0.1% by weight in homogeneous materials. Where designed to be soldered at high temperatures, TI Pb-Free products are suitable for use in specified lead-free processes. **Pb-Free** (RoHS Exempt): This component has a RoHS exemption for either 1) lead-based flip-chip solder bumps used between the die and package, or 2) lead-based die adhesive used between the die and leadframe. The component is otherwise considered Pb-Free (RoHS compatible) as defined above.

Green (RoHS & no Sb/Br): TI defines "Green" to mean Pb-Free (RoHS compatible), and free of Bromine (Br) and Antimony (Sb) based flame retardants (Br or Sb do not exceed 0.1% by weight in homogeneous material)



THERMAL INFORMATION

This package incorporates an exposed thermal pad that is designed to be attached directly to an external heatsink. The thermal pad must be soldered directly to the printed circuit board (PCB). After soldering, the PCB can be used as a heatsink. In addition, through the use of thermal vias, the thermal pad can be attached directly to the appropriate copper plane shown in the electrical schematic for the device, or alternatively, can be attached to a special heatsink structure designed into the PCB. This design optimizes the heat transfer from the integrated circuit (IC).


